#### **Committee Information**

*Bond Projects:* Mr. Robertson and Mr. Seeba reviewed the completed scope of work from Phases 1, 2a and 2b. Bids for bond projects in Phase 2c (Lexan glazing districtwide and classroom security locksets at the high school) were approved on October 13. The committee discussed the updated SED bid process, which should streamline the approval timeline. Mr. Robertson will attend the December committee meeting to provide revised plans for the security vestibules at the elementary buildings.

*Tenants:* Divine Rhythms has requested to air-condition the Westbrook cafeteria, which is used as an acro room. Before moving forward, the committee requested to cost to meter the cafeteria and any associated costs to the district to maintain the air conditioners, which would be placed on the roof of Westbrook.

*Cameras:* Approximately 13 exterior cameras were recently added to the grounds districtwide. The locations were selected based on security concerns and recent incidents. More exterior and interior cameras will be added through the school year.

*Bayview playground:* The Bayview PTA has requested approval to donate funds to pay all costs associated with the installation of a Gaga Pit on its playground. In the interest of fairness and equity district wide, the Board committee members have requested more information.

*Westbrook Parking Lot:* The district is attempting to schedule asphalt paving of an area in the Westbrook parking lot, but the timing conflicts with tenant needs. The project may need to be delayed until late spring/early summer, or another less pressing time for the tenants.
