1. Donations

- a. As discussed at the March meeting, the support beams do not meet the more stringent codes required to mount the new scoreboard on the turf field. The cost to the district to correct the situation will be at least \$30,000. The committee discussed options with representatives of the youth leagues in attendance, but it is unlikely the scoreboard will be mounted in time for the Fall 2015 sports season.
- b. The committee expressed gratitude to the youth programs for donating safety netting for the lacrosse field at the high school. Once the costs to install the netting is determined, the district will how best to accomplish the installation if the district if financially able to accept the donation.
- c. Rocco Pepe from the West Islip Beautification shared plans to place a gazebo for community use on the southwest corner of the library fields. Concerns were raised regarding the maintenance and management of the structure. The project must be given additional consideration.

2. Permits

- a. West Islip Youth Football has requested the Beach or Udall football field for Fall 2015. Historically, those fields have been allocated to the West Islip Soccer Club, but the club has agreed to share the Beach field.
- b. The Soccer Club's bathroom project at Masera is complete. All parties are pleased with the quality of the work.

3. Bond Projects:

- a. The committee continued to review a comprehensive list of items and updated associated costs. Additional bond projects were discussed, including equipment for the high school kitchen, lights for the turf field and installation of an additional turf field.
