 <u>Accessibility to buildings by community groups</u> Strangers gained access to Paul J. Bellew after hours, a potential concern in all buildings. Increased funding for additional security staff has been added to the 2019-2020 budget to ensure coverage of all buildings for after-hour activities.

II. <u>Technology update</u>
